August priorities

- Local officers and partner agencies will continue to work to address ongoing neighbour issues in the Jenham Drive area of Sileby.
- Patrols of Sileby Memorial Park following an increase of anti-social behaviour by a small number of people using these facilities.
- To increase the number of people signed up Neighbourhood Link and local watch schemes displaying the Charnwood Watch street signs. To help build partnerships and reduce crime.
- Providing a visible presence across the whole beat area to provide confidence and reassurance to our communities.

July updates

An Injunction was obtained in relation to an occupant on Jenham Drive regarding behaviour which involved a lot of partnership working. Several untaxed and unlicensed vehicles have been recovered across the beat by Pc St Davis.

As ever we work with Charnwood borough council, housing providers and other agencies helping resolve neighbour issues. We have a number of ongoing cases of this nature and conduct a lot of unseen work but this work is vital as it helps vulnerable people and in some cases we can mediate or offer words of advice to deal with it quickly.

We continue to work with a small group of youths that are causing issues and we maintain strong working relationships with youth services and other agencies to manage their behaviour.

The general area of Charnwood has seen a reduction in all types of crime and I would like to think that everyone has played a part in that. Local council, parish councillors, Charnwood Watch schemes, business and some targeted and smart patrols by the team have undoubtedly contributed to this. There has been no spikes of crime in any area reported so I am pleased to say we do not have any current threat area.
