Charnwood Local Plan Examination Main Modification Consultation:

The Pre-Submission Charnwood Local Plan 2021 – 2037 was submitted to the Secretary of State in December 2021 for Examination in Public pursuant to Regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, as amended. Examination Hearing Sessions were held in June 2022, October 2022, February 2023 and February 2024. The Inspectors undertaking the Examination, Sarah Housden BA (Hons) MRTPI and Hayden Baugh-Jones BA(Hons) DipLA MA CMLI, have identified where changes (main modifications) are necessary to make the Local Plan sound and legally compliant. These are included in the Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications which will be published for a seven-week period of consultation commencing on Wednesday 17th July and ending at 5pm on Wednesday 4th September. Councillor E Jones reported that she had attended the Flooding Scrutiny Panel with Councillor R Butler. The consensus at the meeting was that Charnwood Borough Council dealt well with the recent flooding, but Leicestershire County Council did not, with not enough staff deployed to deal with the issues or road closures etc.

Councillor R Butler had attended a site meeting with James Woolsey, Charnwood Borough Council, to discuss the drainage pipe/ditch adjacent to the allotment site. Further investigations are ongoing to try to resolve the issue of flooding to properties on Ratcliffe Road.

Councillor R Butler asked members if they would like him to ask Toby Jessen, Environment Agency, to attend a meeting to explain Riparian Rights and Responsibilities. Council agreed to this, and asked if he could attend prior to a Parish Council meeting, as there would be a lot to discuss.

Councillor K McRae has arranged a meeting with Severn Trent on Thursday 25th July 2024 at 1.00pm to discuss their land adjacent to the brook. He has also invited Toby Jessen (EA) to attend. Any Councillor welcome to attend.

A Christmas Working Party had just taken place, to look into sourcing a new company to install the Christmas lighting. The Deputy Clerk to contact a few local commercial electricians and send out details of what would be required.

A meeting was held at Sileby Cemetery to discuss the unsafe memorials over 100 years old. The office will be sending out an information pack on the relevant graves for members to consider options. This will then go on a future agenda for consideration.

Councillor J Jones updated Council on the Community Garden. A meeting has been scheduled for the 2^{nd of} August 2024 at 1.00pm in the Community Centre to discuss further.
